- Architectural Control Committee.** The responsibility of the Architectural Control Committee is to review Improvement Requests and insure the submitted improvement conforms to the Community's recorded Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions and/or approved Architectural Guidelines.
- Welcome/Social Committee.** The responsibility of the Welcome/Social Committee is to assist the Board in welcoming new residents to the Community and the planning of social activities to promote community involvement for the benefit of all residents. Traditional projects include but not limited to the planning of community events, welcome baskets, establish "Block Captains", etc. Events may include community wide garage sales, block parties, picnics/BBQ and other activities.
- Safety Committee.** The responsibility of the Safety Committee is to advise and assist the Board in researching, developing and implement programs to promote safety, deter speeding, and crime prevention for the members of the Association such as COPS, National Night Out, HEAT and street safety. Traditional projects include but not limited to working with city planners on street signs, speed humps, inadequate street lighting, and additional security patrols by private vendors.
- Landscape/Beautification Committee.** The responsibility of the Landscape Committee is to assist the Board in routinely reviewing the maintenance and operations of all Association Common Areas where landscaping exists, and all irrigation systems that support this landscaping. Traditional projects include but not limited to "Yard of the Month" contests, Holiday Decoration contests, planning of programs such as "Community Wide Cleanup Day", recommending seasonal color selections, reporting of "unseen violations", and reporting of equipment failures to the HOA offices.
- Communications Committee.** The responsibility of the Communications Committee is to form a network of communications among the entire Association, the Board, and Committees. This may include publication of a Community Newsletter, a Directory of Members, a World Wide Website, Community Alerts or other forms of media.
- Board of Directors.** Please check if you are interested in placing your name in nomination to serve on the Board of Directors. The Board is elected by the membership during our Annual Membership Meetings.
