Please help us get the word out! **FREE PET LICENCES!**

The City of San Antonio recently changed the ordinances governing pets in our community and a key revision focuses on pet licensing. **All cats and dogs must now be licensed** and to encourage adherence to this important law, Animal Care Services is offering residents the opportunity to get their pet licenses **FREE** of charge for a limited time. Normal fees are \$5 for a neutered animal and \$50 for an intact one but it's free right now. Remember, a license is your pets' ticket home so don't delay; get your free pet licenses today, either by coming down to the ACS Shelter off Hwy 151 or on-line via two websites:

We'll mail license tags to you but please don't forget that a rabies vaccination is also required. If your pet needs a shot you can have this performed at your local veterinary office or you can bring your pet to one of our low cost clinics.
